Matching Gift, Benefits, and Contest Rules

This campaign will run September 10-October 12, 2018. Although contributions will be welcomed at any time, October 12 is the last day contributions will be eligible for the benefits and contest.

All new or increased gifts will be matched, up to \$1,500. Eligible match amount is based on total annual commitment. (Ex: You increase your gift from \$2 to \$3.50/pay period. Your match amount is \$1.50x24 pay periods = \$36.)
