Important Dates and Times

Dec. 4 @ 4 p.m. – Deadline to submit grant ideas

Dec. 9 @ 10 a.m. – “Top 10” grant ideas posted by AEF staff to the AEF Facebook page and voting opens

Dec. 17 @ 10 p.m. – Voting deadline

Dec. 18 @ 10 a.m. – Grant winner is announced

Grant Idea Submission

Tell us, in 30 words or less, how you would use \$250 to enhance education. Include your name, school, and grade or subject you teach (this doesn't count toward the 30 word maximum). Submit your idea to the AEF via email to kaufmanlori@asd.k12.wi.us by 4 p.m. on December 4. Do not post your grant idea to the AEF Facebook page.

Eligibility

All AASD educators are eligible to submit one grant idea. Educators from a single school may jointly submit an idea. Ten grants will be selected by an AEF committee for the Facebook competition, thus creating the “Top 10.”

Educators who have applied for an Appleton Education Foundation “Choose Your Focus” (CYF) grant in the 2013 fall grant cycle are eligible to submit the same idea for the Facebook grant competition. If the AEF fully funds the request through “CYF” the idea will be withdrawn from the competition. If the idea is not funded, or only partially funded, the idea will remain eligible.

Before submitting your idea, it wouldn't hurt to share your idea with your principal/administrator to be sure he or she is supportive. The winner will be asked to update the AEF on the progress of the grant.

Voting

The “Top 10” grant ideas will be posted in a Facebook album on the AEF Facebook page by an AEF staff member on Monday, December 9. People should “like” the image of the grant idea they like best.

One “like” equals one vote.

Encourage your colleagues, school families, friends, etc. to vote for their (and hopefully your) favorite idea. Post it and share your idea on your own timeline. But, be sure people are actually going to the AEF album and liking the original post so their vote counts.

Voting is open December 9-17.

Voters also are encouraged to like the AEF page so they will be notified when the winner is announced.
