



Grant Recipients based on Knowledge Open scores

Appleton Career Academy – \$2,650 – Funds will purchase laptops.

Central High School – \$600 – This grant will support the Wisconsin Avenue Planter Project.

East High School – \$300 – Proceeds will support East's Patriot March 5K and Kids Run, a healthy kids initiative.

Edison Elementary School – \$81.25 – This grant will support guidance department initiatives.

Einstein Middle School – \$981.25 – Funds will purchase laptops.

Ferber Elementary School – \$100 – Books and bins for the school's new "bookroom" will be purchased.

Foster Elementary School – \$1,250 – Radios to increase security at the school will be purchased.

Horizons Elementary School – \$100 – The United for Reading Success program will be supported with this grant.
