2019-20

- \$2,000 to purchase Piper Computer Kits; students will learn how to build and program a computer (Melissa Schmidt)

2018-19

- \$2,000 for equipment students use to remove invasive species from local habitats and promote the reintroduction of native species (Eric Vander Loop)

- \$2,250 for xylophones and mallets to help students make concrete connections between pitches they hear and where those notes belong on the music staff (Patty Merrifield)

2017-18

- \$350 to create a multisensory space to enhance literacy within a first-grade classroom (Alex Allinger)

- \$1,255 for Ozobots; students use these tiny robots to learn coding and other STEM skills (Melissa Schmidt)
