Appleton Public Montessori – \$1,850 – Funds will be used towards the purchase of a new washer and dryer.

Badger Elementary School – \$1,875 – Literacy materials will be purchased with this award.

East High School – \$525 – Funds will be used for professional development.

Edison Elementary School – \$650 – This grant will be directed to the Edison Elementary School Fund within the Appleton Education Foundation.

Einstein Middle School – \$150 – This award will help support low-income families during the holidays.

Ferber Elementary School – \$225 – The grant will be directed to the Edna Ferber Elementary School Endowment Fund within the AEF.
