



## 2019 | Grant Recipients

*Appleton Public Montessori* – \$825 will be used to support professional development opportunities for staff.

*Badger Elementary School* – \$1,075 to increase school safety and security.

*East High School* – \$825 will support the “Patriot Process” – a systematic strategy for building school culture.

*Einstein Middle School* – \$2,725 will fund an all-staff book study of *Blind Spot* and additional professional development efforts related to being a culturally responsive school.

*Ferber Elementary School* – \$550 to purchase Chromebooks.

*Foster Elementary Charter School* – \$1,175 for schoolwide Dreambox licenses. Dreambox is an adaptive, online K-8 math program.

*Horizons Elementary School* – \$350 for new playground toys: balls, jump ropes, etc.

*Houdini Elementary School* – \$3,025 will purchase new furniture for the library.

*Jefferson Elementary School* – \$1,100 for culturally diverse books and efforts in the physical education and music departments. \$100 for the music department in appreciation for volunteer time at the event.

*North High School* – \$1,200 will support initiatives including Sources of Strength, an at-risk food pantry and “North Refresh” culture work.

*Richmond Elementary School* – \$150 will purchase whiteboards for classrooms.

*Valley New School* – \$775 for the school’s contribution toward a new bubbler and water bottle filler.

*West High School* – \$1,225 will be used to support Launch Studio activities (career-based learning). \$125 to the golf team in appreciation for students’ volunteer time at the event.

*Wisconsin Connections Academy* – \$150 for a team building activity.
