

Dave Hussey Memorial Scholarship

About Dave Hussey:

Mr. Hussey taught Math and Physical Education and coached Gymnastics in the Appleton Area School District from 1969 to 1976 and ran the Intramural Program for a short time. He also served area students in his role as administrator. The intent of this scholarship is to continue his commitment to education and his encouragement to students who wish to pursue a college degree.

Amount of Award:

One, \$1,000 nonrenewable scholarship.

Who May Apply:

Students graduating from Appleton East, North and West high schools who intend to pursue a post-secondary degree. The award rotates among these schools, in the order noted below:

2025: Appleton North 2026: Appleton West 2027: Appleton East

Basis for Selection:

Students who have maintained a 3.0 GPA, participated in extra-curricular activities, and volunteered in the community.

How to Apply:

Access the <u>Scholarship Portal</u> and complete the *Appleton Education Foundation Universal Application*. AEF shares this portal with the Community Foundation for the Fox Valley Region and Women's Fund. Check both for additional scholarship opportunities.

Selection:

Recipient is selected in spring by the high school's Scholarship Selection Committee, according to the award criteria. The school will notify the Appleton Education Foundation after the selection is made.

Timing:

The application deadline is noted on the <u>AEF website</u>. All applicants will be notified of the selection committee's decision by the end of May. The recipient must provide proof of enrollment to the Appleton Education Foundation prior to release of the scholarship check.
