



Scoring and Grant Payouts 2026

Overview

Both the 18- and 9-hole events are scrambles. Teams golf to earn unrestricted grants for participating Appleton Area School District schools. More than \$16,000 will be awarded the day of the event. Each participating school will receive a minimum of \$250.

Each course has hole activities (longest drive, longest putt, etc.). The winner of each contest will earn a \$250 grant for their assigned school. Any individual who successfully completes the Putting Contest can win \$250 for an AASD school of their choice. *(Teams must have the Activity Package to participate in these opportunities.)*

All teams that answer the 19th Hole question correctly will be entered in a drawing. The winning team will earn \$250 for their assigned school.

18-hole

Prizes (grant money) will be awarded to the schools represented by the teams with the lowest gross scramble score and highest Masters Knowledge Challenge quiz score (\$250 awards for each). Prizes for 1st-15th will be awarded based on gross scramble scores less ½ stroke for each correct quiz answer. In an effort to distribute awards to a variety of schools, grants will be awarded as outlined below:

9-hole

Prizes (grant money) will be awarded to the schools represented by the teams with the lowest gross scramble score and highest Masters Knowledge Challenge quiz score (\$250 awards for each). Prizes for 1st-7th will be awarded based on gross scramble scores less ½ stroke for each correct quiz answer. In an effort to distribute awards to a variety of schools, grants will be awarded as outlined below:

1 st : \$625	2 nd : \$550	3 rd : \$500	4 th : \$250	5 th : \$450

Breaking Ties

In the event of a tie for 1st-15th and 1st-7th in the respective events, the team that answered the 19th hole quiz question correctly will be placed ahead. If the tied teams all answered the question correctly or incorrectly, the second tie breaker will be overall quiz score. The team with the highest score will be placed ahead. If a tie remains after those two tie breakers, the teams will share the grant evenly (ie: if there is a two-way tie for 4th place, the awards for 4th and 5th will be split evening between the two teams).
